Kids Can Achieve

5-18

Kids Can Achieve (KCA) supports children and young people aged 5+ with learning disabilities and autism to build confidence and independence. They offer inclusive after-school, weekend and holiday clubs, plus personalised one-to-one support in Harrow.



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D-Triumph Care

5-18

D-Triumph Care's Short Breaks in Harrow offer tailored support for children with additional needs, building confidence and independence through fun, structured activities. These include trips to parks, swimming, cinema, soft play, and community outings.

0-25

All For Care offers person-centred short breaks for children and young people aged 0-25, promoting independence and wellbeing. The service combines safe care with community activities, giving families meaningful respite.



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Better Families Social Work Services

0-25

Providing CQC-registered short breaks and support for children with disabilities, including personal assistance and hospital watch. Their service offers safe, specialised care while giving families essential respite.



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Harrow Carers

5-18

Harrow Carers provides short breaks and support for children and young people, offering opportunities to relax, have fun, and give families a break from caring responsibilities.



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Care4ocus

0-18

Care4ocus provides person-centred Short Breaks Care for children and young people up to 18, supporting independence and wellbeing. Their service includes tailored care, community activities, and respite for families.



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Community Connex

5-18

A range of fun activities for children and young people aged 5-18 in Harrow, supporting independence.



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Care Consort

13-18

Horizons offers creative, therapeutic short breaks for young people aged 13-18 with additional needs. Their structured sessions build confidence, independence, and emotional wellbeing through engaging, personalised support.



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Star Maris

6-16

Star Maris offers a “home away from home” short breaks service for children aged 6–16, with fun community activities like bowling and swimming while providing respite for families.



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Endorphins

8-16

Inclusive sessions for SEND children and young people, offering activities like dance, drama, arts, and games in a safe, supportive environment. With a high staff ratio, the service helps build confidence, friendships, and participation for all abilities.



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Gold Crest

5-18

Gold Crest provides short breaks in Harrow for children aged 5–18, with sports, creative activities, and after-school sessions. The service supports independence and offers families planned respite.



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Lifeserve Solutions

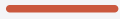
