

# ANSWERS TO HAY HARROW QUIZ QUESTIONS – POSTER FOR STAFFROOMS

## #1

*What percentage say they worry about their family not having enough money for food?*

**Answer – 12%**

**Summary:**

10% of all pupils from KS 2 to KS 5 worry that they or their family will not have food as they lack money or other resources. The figure for those in college is 18% which increases the overall borough total to 12%.

## #2

*What percentage feel unsafe in their own home some or all of the time?*

**Answer – 12%**

**Summary:**

About 2% across all groups said they felt unsafe in their own home, and a further 10% said they felt unsafe in their own homes some of the time, so 12% of Harrow young people feel unsafe in their own homes some or all of the time.

## #3

*What percentage say they (in KS4/5) have been the victim of sexual harassment?*

**Answer – 13%**

**Summary:**

Overall 13% of young people in KS4/5 + college said they had been a victim of sexual harassment. Of these, 28% of non-binary, 19% of girls and 7% of boys felt that they had experienced sexual harassment.

*What percentage say they have fizzy drinks at least several times a week?*

**Answer – 28%**

**Summary:**

28% said they had a fizzy drink several times a week or every day of the week.

*What percentage say they like school / college a bit or a lot?*

**Answer – 83%**

**Summary:**

83% said they liked school or college a bit or a lot. This figure is higher in primary (90%) than in KS4/5 (65%). College is also quite high (88%).

*What percentage say their family helps and supports them?*

**Answer – 84%**

**Summary:**

Overall 84% said they feel their family supports them. This is higher in KS2 (90%) than in KS4/5 (70%).
